

Bruning Public School Board of Education Special Meeting Minutes  
Friday, July 24, 2009  
Meeting Held at Betty's Café – Main Street – Bruning, Nebraska

Board President Dan Domeier called the meeting to order at 12:08 PM at Betty's Café, Bruning, Nebraska.

Present were Board members: Dan Domeier, Bruce Houchin, Dave Messman, Jody Weber, Sarah Bolte and Jerry Catlett. Also present: Trudy Clark, Superintendent and Mike Brown, Principal. Other members of the public were in the café and did not participate in the meeting.

President Domeier recognized the Nebraska Open Meeting Law Section 84-1408: Declaration of intent; meeting open to the public. It is hereby declared to be the policy of this state that the information of public policy is public business and may not be conducted in secret. Every meeting of a public body shall be open to the public in order that citizens may exercise their democratic privilege of attending and speaking at meetings of public bodies, except as otherwise provided by the constitution of Nebraska, federal statutes, and the Open Meeting Act.

A copy of the Opening Meetings Act pamphlet was made available at the table used for the Board Meeting.

Minutes of the June 15, 2009 meeting had been mailed earlier, were available for review and approved.

Old business: proposal for cooperation with Shickley.

Discussion was held on the past proposals from Shickley that were not approved by the Bruning Davenport Unified Board and the counter proposal that was rejected by Shickley Board of Education.

By consensus, the Board directed Superintendent Clark to contact Unified Board President Mike Schroder and Davenport Community Schools Board President Rod Tegtmeier to let inform them that the Bruning Board of Education will accept proposal number 1 from Shickley over a 2-year period: the 2, 2 and 2 proposal for football, basketball and volleyball.

At 12:50 PM Jerry Catlett made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Sarah Bolte.
