### Educator Pipeline Collaborative (EPiC) Pathway

Doane has a reputation of being one of the best educator preparatory programs and is accredited by the Council for Accreditation of Educator Preparation.

The EPiC pathway prepares future teachers and educators with the skills, resources and confidence to lead a classroom. Students begin their journey toward a career as an education professional, earn credit toward their bachelor's degree in education, complete practicum hours in the classroom and network with fellow future educators.
