

Water Bottles

District-Provided Water Bottles

- All students will be provided with a **clear, reusable water bottle** at the beginning of the school year.
- These bottles are intended for daily use and should be brought to school each day, filled with water.

Personal Water Bottles

- Students may choose to bring their own **personal water bottle**, but it **must be clear** (transparent) to ensure contents are visible.
- Water bottles should be durable, non-glass, and have a secure lid to prevent spills.

Contents

- **Water is the only approved beverage** in water bottles during the school day.
- Students **may not bring outside beverages**, such as juice, soda, energy drinks, coffee, or flavored water.
- Bottles found to contain anything other than water will be confiscated, and parents/guardians may be notified.

Usage Guidelines

- Water bottles are allowed in classrooms, hallways, and during recess or PE, unless otherwise directed by a teacher.
- Students should use their water bottles responsibly and avoid disruptions (e.g., squirting water, excessive trips to refill, sharing bottles with others).

Exceptions for Special Occasions

- On designated special occasions such as classroom celebrations, movie days, or holiday parties, teachers may allow students to bring a special drink.
- These events will be communicated in advance, and any non-water beverages must be consumed during the designated celebration time and not throughout the day.
- Outside drinks are not permitted outside of these approved events.
